VIBC hosts first ever Biathlon BC Range Safety Officials Course

Congratulations to the eight Vancouver Island Biathlon Club coaches and volunteers who attended the first ever Biathlon BC Range Safety Officer Course at Mount Washington on Dec 29, 2018.

The range safety officer course demonstrates Biathlon BC's continuing commitment to provide professional development to the Biathlon Range Safety Officers and to enhance the safety standard of all Biathlon ranges across BC.

Operation V Board: Fundraiser Through Strathcona Nordic Ski Club

Cross Country BC has organised a fundraiser and sent out the challenge for BC clubs to join in! Our sister club, Strathcona Nordics has chosen to raise funds for V-boards.

V Boards are important because they are used to mark race courses. As the current V Boards have fallen into disrepair, we are asking members of our Nordic family to contribute to purchasing new V Boards. Details to note:

- 1. SNSC is asking members to step up and donate \$25 the cost of a V-board. You donate that amount and you can sign your V-board at our "signing ceremony"!
- 2. Donors have the option of receiving a tax receipt for donations of \$50 or greater (and, at \$50 can sign 2 boards).
- 3. Donations made by December 31, 2018 will get 2018 tax receipts and after that date the tax receipts will be for 2019.
- 4. Our goal is \$5000 which would give us 200 V-boards.
- 5. While the challenge is open until February 28, 2019 by contributing early in the challenge you can help the club get V-boards in time for our Teck Cup and Loppet 2019 races in March 2019

Three anonymous provincial donors have stepped up and will be contributing up to a total of \$15,000 in matching funds. The \$15,000 will be handed out as follows, until it's gone:

- an initial \$100 to every club that raises \$200 on their own
- a further \$200 to every club that raises \$600 on their own
- a further \$500 to every club that raises \$1600 on their own

(If you're doing the math, that's a total contribution of \$800 on the first \$1,600 that the club raises... a 50% match!).
