

Coach Remuneration Policy 2023

This policy is aimed to provide clarification and transparency with respect to coach remuneration for VIBC Programs.

Lead Coach for a Program

- 1 Lead Coach needed for each program session (Bears, Rec Youth, Rec Adult)
- Minimum requirements:
 - Silver Community Coaching Course
 - Criminal Record Check
 - PAL
- Remuneration:
 - Honorarium of \$30/session (\$300/season)
 - Mount Washington coaching pass (1/2 of a Nordic Season pass)*

Assistant Coaches

- Minimum requirements:
 - Criminal Record Check
 - An interest in learning more about biathlon
- Encouraged (but not necessary):
 - PAL
 - Some experience with skiing and/or shooting
- Remuneration:
 - Mount Washington coaching passes (1/2 of a Nordic Season pass)*
 - No honorarium provided for programs of 6 or fewer athletes
 - Honorarium indexed to size of the group, using 1:6 coach-to-athlete ratio.
 - May be divided up amongst multiple assistant coaches
- Opportunities for learning:
 - Coaching Development Program
 - Silver Course

Coaching for Extra Programs

- There will be no honorarium provided to coach extra programs, including:
 - Give it a Shot
 - School Programs
 - Strathcona Nordic Adventure Program (SNAP)
